basketball 1961-1962

The 1961-62 basketball season was a highly successful one for the Spartans as they posted a 13-3 Pikes Peak record and a 15-3 mark in regular season play to win their third consecutive league basketball championship.

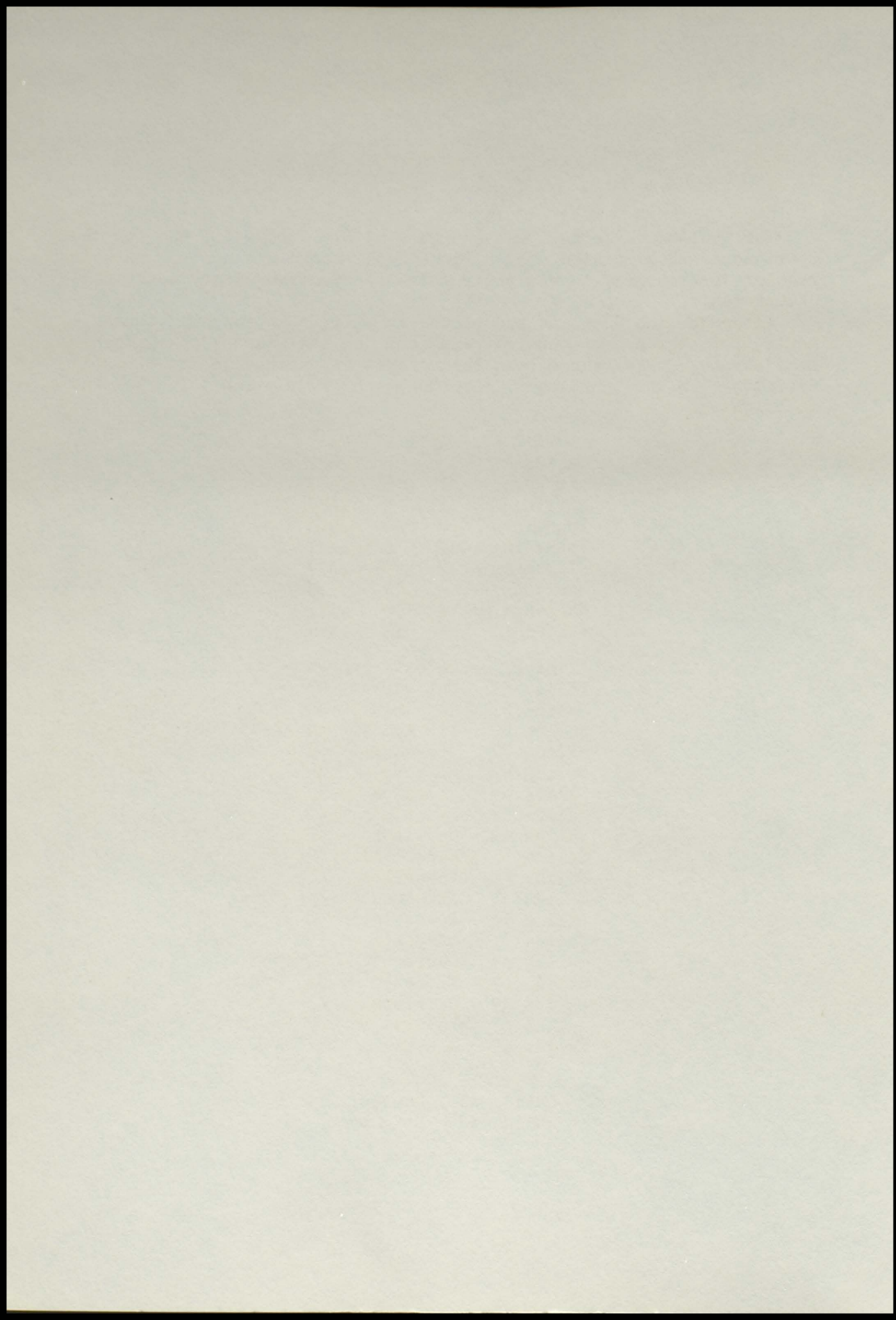

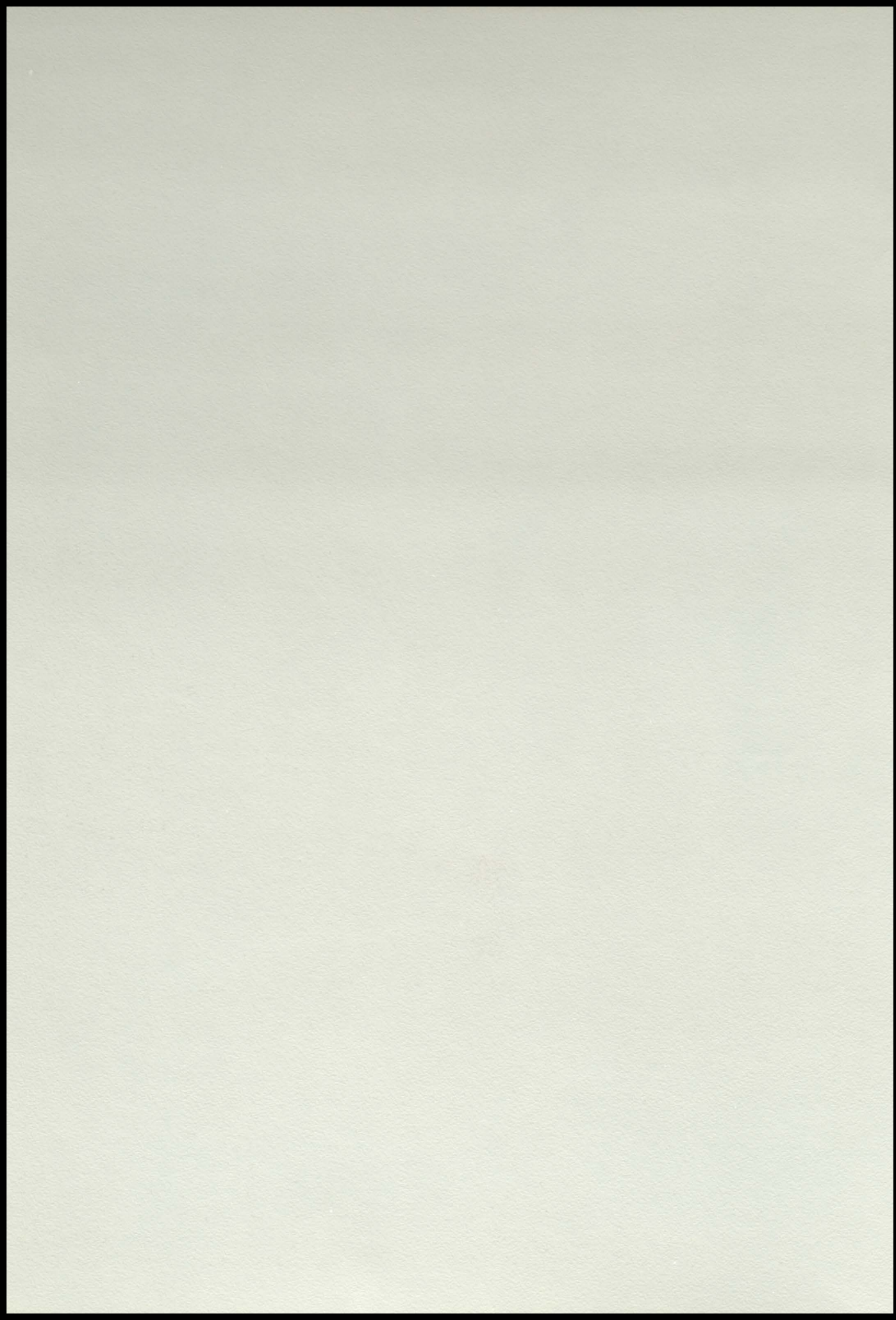

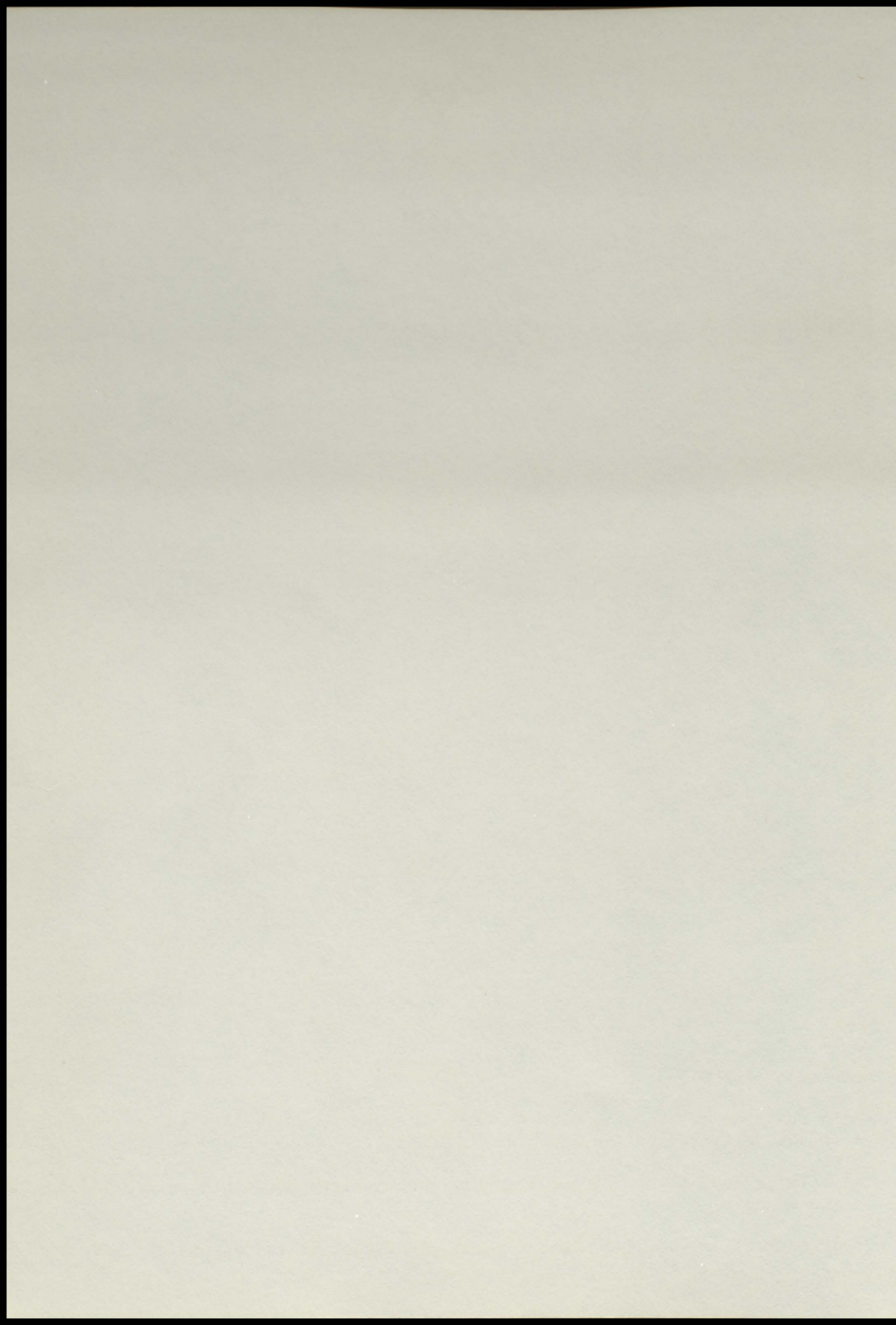
This has been the busiest and perhaps' the most successful year for the ninety members of Pep Club.
