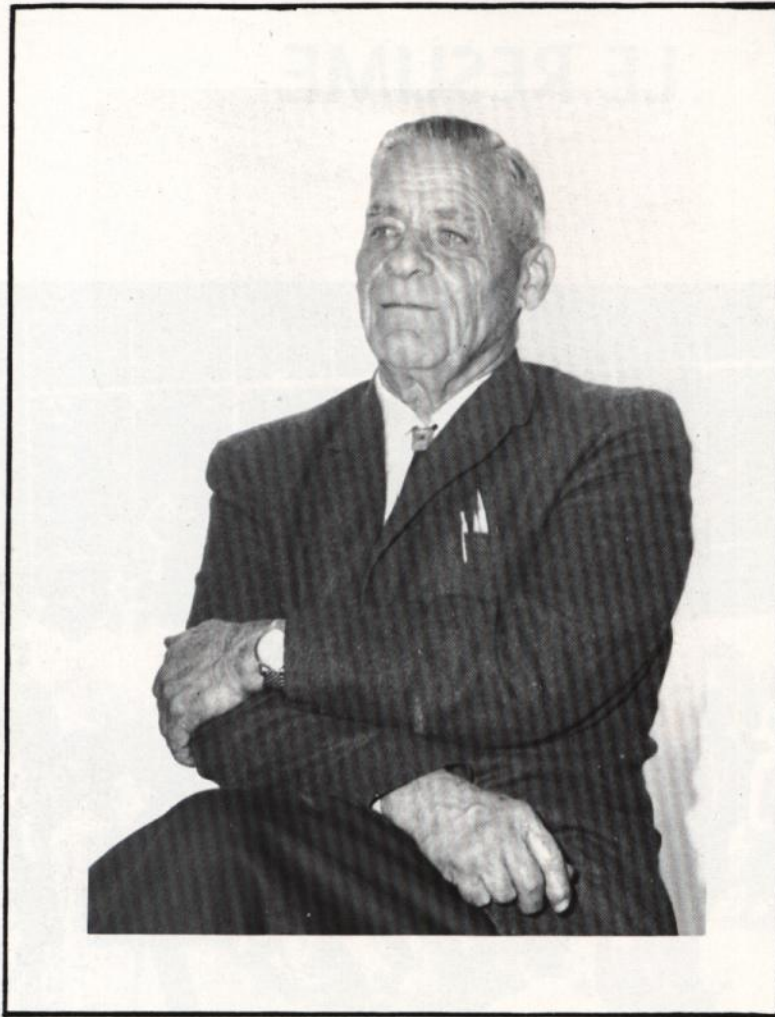

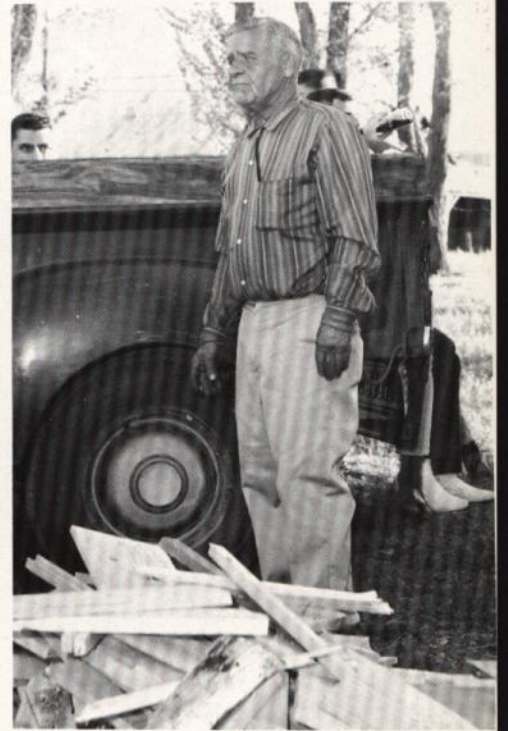


E. C. "Gov" Gruenler, who has served Salida High School for 37 years, has announced his retirement at the end of this school year.

- .....The senior class scored higher in scholastic achievement tests than any former class.



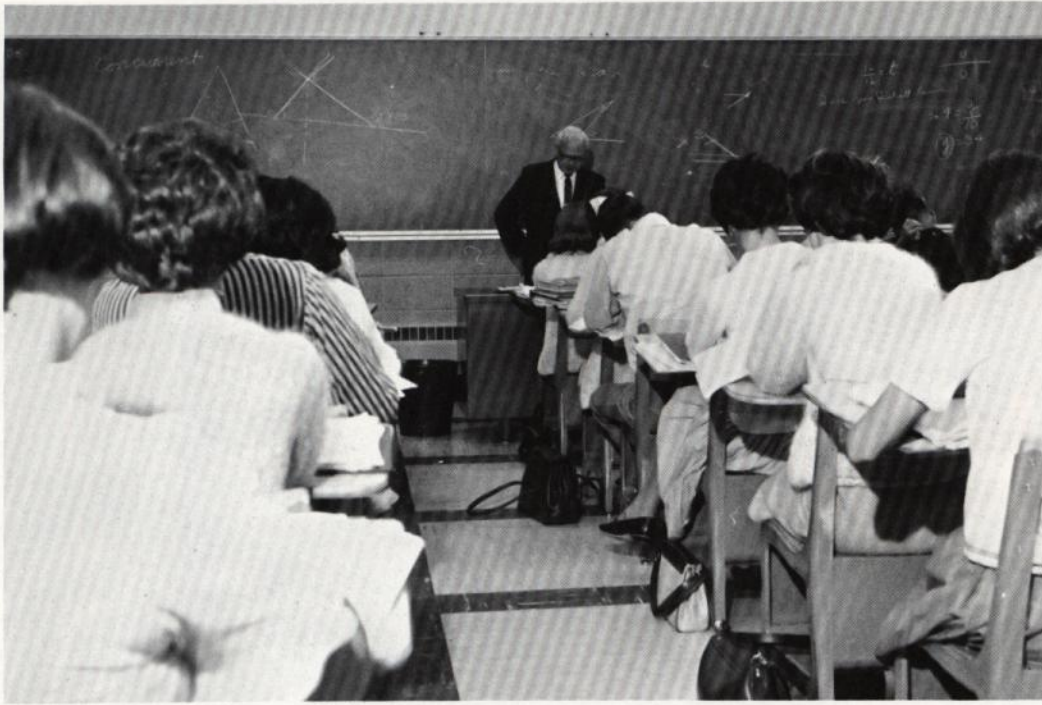
