TOWN OF CLEORA
MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

October 4, 1879

Members of Board of Trustees: W. A. Hawkins, Mayor; J. M. Johnson, John Toms, M. M. French, John T Blake, R. B. Hallock, secretary.

On motion of John T. Blake, seconded by M. M. French, the Mayor appointed the following persons a committee on Rules and Licenses, John T. Blake, M. M. French and John Toms.

On motion of John t. Blake, seconded by John Toms, G. W. Bower was elected by ballot to office of Marshal.

On motion of John T. Blake, seconded by M. M. French, J. M. Johnson was elected by ballot to the office of Treasurer.

On motion of J. M. Johnson, seconded by M. M. French, W. A. Hawkins was chosen Police Judge.

On motion of M. M. French, W. A. Hawkins was declared Police Judge from this 4th day of October, A. D. 1879.

On motion of John T. Blake, W. W. Dunbar was elected by ballot to the office of corporate attorney for the Town of Cleora.

On motion of John Toms, W. W. Dunbar was placed on the committee on Rules and Licenses.

On motion of John Toms the Mayor was empowered to issue a license for the sale of liquor in the Town of Cleora to Baxter Stingley.

October 21, 1879

A motion of J. M. Johnson, the limits of incorporation as presented by the Attorney was approved.

A motion by J. M. Johnson, the Rules as read by the Clerk, governing the meetings of the Board of Trustees were adopted.

An ordinance prohibiting pigs and hogs from running presented by W. A. Hawkins and was adopted.

On motion of J. M. Johnson, the committee on Rules and Licenses was instructed to draft a fire ordinance, and report at the next meeting.

November 3, 1879

On motion of John T. Blake, the Town Attorney was instructed to copy such ordinances as are necessary for immediate use.

Bill presented by W. A. Hawkins of \$8.55 for Town Seal. Ordered paid.

November 8, 1879

An ordinance establishing regular meetings of Board of Trustees presented by John T. Blake was adopted.

An ordinance concerning ordinances presented by Chairman of Committee was adopted.

An ordinance concerning licenses presented by Chairman of

Committee was adopted.

November 8, 1879

An ordinance concerning proceedings before Police Magistrate of Justice of Peace presented by Chairman of committee adopted.

An ordinance concerning Town Officers presented by Chairman of Committee on ordinances adopted.

November 17, 1879

An ordinance concerning the sale of intoxicating liquors as presented by M. M. French and read by town Attorney was adopted.

An ordinance concerning the construction of chimneys presented by M. M. French was adopted.

An ordinance concerning misdemeanors presented by M. M. French adopted.

February 12, 1880

Bill of W. W. Dunbar for \$10 for services in completing organization of Town was allowed.

On motion John T. Blake was appointed Commissioner to act with the Railroad Companies in behalf of the town of Cleora.

On motion the funds remaining in the treasury were appropriated to defray the expenses of Commissioner.

February 13, 1880

Moved and seconded that the \$40.00 remaining in the treasury be appropriated to defray the expenses of John T. Blake, Commissioner to act in behalf of the Town of Cleora with the Railroad Companies carried with the members of the board voting as follows: Against, M. M. French, J. M. Johnson. For: John Toms, R. B. Hallock, and William A. Hawkins.

On motion the office of Town attorney was declared vacant.

J. M. Johnson announced his resignation as Treasurer of town of Cleora which accepted.

The Board then proceeded to nominate and elect a Treasurer to fill the vacancy which resulted in the election of John Toms.

On motion the Clerk was instructed to return the seal to the manufacturers and have the date changed to correspond with the date of the incorporation of the town.

On motion an ordinance providing for the revision of all the ordinances heretofore passed was received and accepted.

On motion the Annual Appropriation bill for the next fiscal year was received and accepted as presented.

On motion the Clerk was instructed to publish notices of the town election to be held at the Grand View Hotel April 6, 1880.

March 16, 1880

On motion W. S. Smyth, special attorney, proceeded to read the ordinance as revised and amended by him.

On motion the ordinances as revised and amended by special attorney W. S. Smyth were received and adopted.

April 7, 1880

On motion the Clerk was instructed to transfer Baxter Stingley's Saloon license to Wasson & Welton.

The following members of new Board being sworn in, the meeting was called to order by Mayor, W. A. Hawkins, M. M. French, E. H. Webb and R. B. Hallock.

It being necessary to elect a treasurer, Mr. Toms was placed in nomination and voted upon and elected by ballot.

April 26, 1880

On motion the following committee of three was appointed to draw plans and solicit bids for the building of a calaboose, E. H. Webb, John Toms, M. M. French.

May 4, 1880

On motion the report of committee on calaboose was postponed until the next regular meeting.

Moved by John Toms and seconded by R. B. Hallock that the Board appropriate \$13.50 out of the town Treasury to defray the expenses of E. H. Webb to Colorado Springs to confer with the Railroad officials in behalf of the town of Cleora. The vote being called the members voted as follows: John Toms "aye", E. H. Webb "aye". M. M. French "Nay". Carried.

May 27, 1880

The oath of office was administered to John T. Blake.

On motion of M. M. French, \$15.00 was allowed for fixing bridge at foot of Colorado Street. Carried.
