MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SALIDA, COLORADO FOR 1880.

October 28, 1880

On motion of O. V. Wilson, the plans for a calaboose presented by W. F. Galbraith was accepted.

On motion of O. V. Wilson, William A. Hawkins was appointed to the office of Police Magistrate.

On motion of W. F. Galbraith, James S. Meadows was appointed to the office of Town Marshal.

On motion of O. V. Wilson, L. W. Craig was chosen to the office of Treasurer.

On motion the salary of the Marshal was fixed at \$60.00 per month.

OCTOBER 29, 1880

On motion the clerk was instructed to publish notice in the Mountain Mail that sealed bids would be received at his office for the building of a calaboose.

On motion Asa Jones was chosen to the office of Town Attorney Protem and salary fixed at \$50.00 per month.

On motion the Rules and Order of business presented by the clerk was passed and adopted.

On motion, Ordinance No. 1, establishing stated meetings of the Board was passed and adopted.

On motion Ordinance No. 2, concerning the duties of the Town Attorney was passed.

On motion Ordinance No. 3, concerning the duties of the Marshal was passed.

On motion Ordinance No. 4, concerning the duties of the Town Treasurer was passed.

On motion the specifications for calaboose presented by W. F. Galbraith was accepted.

October 30, 1880

On motion O. V. Wilson was chosen Chairman Protem.

On motion the clerk was instructed to procure a Town Seal style of same left at his option.

On motion Ordinance No. 5, concerning Misdemeanors voted on by

Sections was adopted.

On motion Ordinance No. 6, concerning licenses was passed and adopted being voted on by Sections.

On motion W. F. Galbraith and R. Wyman were appointed a committee of two to make estimates of the expense of running the town.

November 1, 1880

It being in order the clerk read the bid of Bower and Davis for the building of calaboose which was accepted at \$260.00.

On motion the Attorney was instructed to draft an ordinance to license every business carried on in the town excepting retail dealers in liquors.

On motion an ordinance concerning explosives was passed and adopted.

On motion an Ordinance establishing the Town Seal was adopted.

November 5, 1880

On motion of O. V. Wilson the report of committee on finance was accepted.

On motion an Ordinance concerning Trials before the Police Magistrate was passed.

On motion an Ordinance concerning Fire was accepted and adopted.

On motion an Ordinance concerning Nuisances was passed.

On motion an Ordinance concerning duties of Officers was passed.

On motion an Ordinance concerning Licenses was adopted.

November 6, 1880

On motion of W. F. Galbraith an Ordinance concerning Misdemeanors was voted on by Sections and adopted.

November 10, 1880

On motion Baxter Stingley was appointed Marshal Protem.

On motion the office of Town Attorney was declared vacant and clerk instructed to pay him balance due on salary.

November 15, 1880

On motion of O. V. Wilson, W. F. Galbraith was appointed Clerk and Recorder Protem during the absence of R. B. Hallock. Carried.

The resignation of Baxter Stingley as Marshal was accepted.

On motion of O. V. Wllson, Mr. Harrison was retained as Attorney to prosecute William Baxter the prisoner who shot James Meadows, Town Marshal. Carried.

An Ordinance concerning Fire and Ashes drawn up by O. V. Wilson was passed.

November 30, 1880

On motion of R. W. Wyman, Thomas Reed, Marshal Protem, was discharged and James Meadows retained as regular Marshal. Carried.

On motion an Ordinance concerning the License of Billiard Tables was adopted.
