MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SALIDA FOR THE YEAR 1882.

January 2, 1882

By a motion O. V. Wilson, seconded by M. M. French that the salary of Baxter Stingley be raised from \$60.00 to \$75.00 per month to take effect from January 8, 1882.

An ordinance in regard to smoking opium was read and laid over until next regular meeting.

February 1, 1882

An ordinance in relation to Opium Smoking presented at last meeting was read and adopted.

An ordinance in relation to Jail Breaking was read and on motion of M. M. French seconded by O. V. Wilson that said ordinance be adopted. Carried.

By a motion of O. V. Wilson that the chair appoint a committee of two to secure a room to put fire company's buckets and ladders in. The chair appointed G. F. Bateman and O. V. Wilson.

February 9, 1882

Call meeting to consider the bid of Russell and Alexander water works construction.

The proposition of Russell and Alexander to put in water works was read and on motion of O. V. Wilson seconded by M. M. French that said proposition of \$17,500.00 be accepted, provided the bonds could be disposed of and freight rates from Pueblo to Salida could be arranged satisfactorily. Carried.

By a motion of O. V. Wilson seconded by G. F. Bateman that W. W. Roller be instructed to offer bonds to Mr. Beckwith for 95 cents on the dollar. Carried.

February 20, 1882

By a motion of O. V. Wilson seconded by G. F. Bateman that the clerk be instructed to buy a poll book and Registration Books. Carried.

The proposition of Moore and Olney to put ordinances in pamphlet form was read and referred to finance committee.

March 6, 1882

The following resolution was read and adopted by the Board. Resolved, that in accordance with section 2691, General Laws of the

State of Colorado, a municipal election for the town of Salida is hereby ordered, to be held on the first Tuesday in April, April 4, 1882, for the election of Mayor, Clerk and Recorder, and four other trustees to serve during the ensuing year. Polls will be opened at the office of the Mountain Mail.

April 3, 1882

An ordinance relating to lighting "F" Street Bridge was read and on a motion being made and seconded that said ordinance be adopted. Carried.

An ordinance in Relation to assault and battery was read and on motion being made and seconded that said ordinance be adopted. Carried.

The clerk was notified to instruct Baxter Stingley, marshal, to purchase 6 lamps to light "F" Street Bridge.

The following appropriations for the ensuing year were adopted. Clerk's appropriation \$500.00; Police Appropriation, \$2,500.00; Water Appropriation, \$1,500.00; Street Appropriation, \$1,000.00; Attorney Appropriation, \$1,000.00; Public Park Appropriation, \$500.00; Fire Appropriation, \$1,000.00. Above appropriations were all adopted.
