MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SALIDA FOR 1896:

January ?, 1896

Moved and seconded that the marshal's salary be reduced to \$40 per month with the privilege of doing something else in connection with his duties as marshal. Carried.

Moved and seconded that the salary of the Night Police be reduced to \$50 per month. Carried.

January 20th, 1896

Moved and seconded that the salary of Marshal and night Police be restored to \$85 per month each. Carried.

Moved and seconded that a special water rate be made the Edison Electric Light Company at the rate of \$150 per year to be collected quarterly in advance and the clerk be instructed to collect same from Dec. 1, 1895.

Mr. Leonard, representative of the Daily Mining Record, made a few remarks in support of his paper setting forth the advantage of advertising our mineral resources in the Daily Mining Record and proposing to give us a general writeup also giving to correspondents from time to time for the sum of \$100. Proposition accepted.

February 5, 1896

Moved and seconded that the lights in the council room, jail and hose house be accepted as payment for water used by the Edison Electric Light Co., same to be in effect from December 1, 1895. Carried.

March 30, 1896

Appropriation ordinance for year 1896 passed.

April 13, 1896

S. M. Jackson, Mayor; C. T. Johnson, Clerk and Recorder and Water Commissioner; E. W. Hively, Treasurer; Trustees: F. B. Churcher, R. B. Hallock, Geo. Montgomery. Old Trustees: Erdlen, Hodgman, Clemm.

April 20, 1896

Board of Health, Mayor Jackson, Chairman, R. T. Hodgman, Geo. Montgomery.

Officers' salaries and bonds: Marshal, \$85.00 per month, bond \$1,000; Night Police \$85.00 per month, bond \$750; Street Commissioner, \$75.00 per month, bond of \$500; Town Attorney \$20.00 per month, Bond of \$500.

J. P. Harper, Street Commissioner; Chas. Ankele, Marshal; H. Angell, Night Police; G. W. McGovern, Police Magistrate.

May 4, 1896

Petition read from J. L. Marvin proposing to sprinkle streets for \$45.00 per month, from the city with privilege to collect what he could from the merchants. Granted.

The matter of extending water mains on C Street was brought up and pretty thoroughly discussed. Accordingly it was moved and seconded that clerk be instructed to make plat and specifications of the proposed extension and call for bills for laying and completion of same.

Bid for 101 cottonwood trees to be set around Alpine Park, from A. C. Brown for 12 1/2 cents each. Accepted and contract awarded him.

May 18, 1896

An ordinance to prevent the loitering, loafing or playing of children upon the streets and alleys, or public places at late or unusual hours was read. Passed.

Bateman Hardware bid accepted for extension of water mains on C Street.

July 20, 1896

Ordinance relating to licensing of Theaters, shows, etc. was read and passed.

\$1,375 paid Bateman Hardware for extension of water mains on C Street.

August 3, 1896

Resignation of H. Angell as Night Police was read and accepted.

A proposition to advertise the town and its resources through the medium of the Salida Mail by subscribing for 1,000 copies at 4 cents a copy was accepted and the clerk authorized to draw a warrant for \$40.

August 17, 1896

James Smith elected Night Policeman.

September 7, 1896

Services of Street Commissioner discontinued for balance of year to take effect September 10th.

October 9, 1896

Tax Levy for year 1896: Interest on bonded indebtedness: 8 1/2 mills; Sinking fund to pay indebtedness, 8 mills.
