MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SALIDA FOR 1897:

INCOMPLETE

January 12, 1897

Resolved that Wallace Schoolfield, Town attorney, be authorized to look after the interests of the town in the suit of R. C. Lippard and the South Arkansas Waterworks and Irrigation Co. vs. J. J. Crippen, Trustee and the Town of Salida in the district court of Chaffee County. Adopted.

March 15, 1897

Appropriation ordinance read and passed.

An ordinance Repealing an ordinance entitled an ordinance concerning Hotel Runners, Hackmen, expressmen and others and any and all ordinances amendatory thereof was read and placed upon its final passage.

April 5, 1897

An ordinance to regulate the manner of using, and the rate of speed of bicycles, tricycles and tandems on certain streets of the town was read and passed.

An ordinance to prohibit the placing of tacks, glass, pieces of wire, and other substances, capable of producing injury to the tires of bicycles, etc. upon the streets of the town was read and passed.
