Presented to notice, the Members of the Cash Creek Park & Lick Company, met at the office of Mr. Chensen this day above mentioned, to organize under the Charter granted them <sup>by the</sup> Legislature of the Territory of <sup>James</sup> Colorado. During the Session of 1862.

James D. Call for this Meeting of the Company, having the same signed by five of the incorporators, named in the Wilson Charter, posted in Cash Creek for ten days previous to this date, as required by the Charter. <sup>Protem</sup> Protem Wilson the Meeting was called to order. J. P. Patten was chosen Pres. <sup>Protem</sup> J. P. Patten Sec. <sup>Protem</sup> J. P. Patten

On Motion the Old Board of Directors, namely - John Goheen, Mr. Chensen & W. Christman, were appointed a Committee of three, to meet with Sup't Justice and the Original Stock Holders at the office of Mr. Chensen during the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September said Committee to figure up from the Books & Reports of said Superintendent and the amount of stock wanted out, by the several Members of the Company. Said Committee also shall open a Stock Book, for the subscription of such stock, by the several persons who may have work placed to their credit on the Books of said Superintendent.

On Motion S. B. Pomeroy, J. P. Patten, Levi Nims, J. P. Patten & <sup>Protem</sup> were appointed a Committee of five to draft a Code of By-Laws for the regulation of the Company under the provisions of the Charter.

On Motion J. P. Patten & <sup>Protem</sup> were appointed a Committee of three to examine the Books of the Superintendent.

On Motion the several Committees were required to report on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Sep. 1862.

On Motion the Meeting adjourned to meet on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Sep. 1862.

Sec. 1<sup>st</sup> It shall be the duty of the President, at all the meetings of the Company Regular & Special, to act as Chairman of the Board of Directors - but shall have no vote on the business matters before the Board & He shall have calls for Special Meetings; shall sign the Certificate of stock also all Checks or Orders on the Treasurer in payment of accounts Bills & Dividends, when

Audited and Ordered to be paid by the Board of Directors. He Shall Sign all Contracts & agreements, Binding the Company, when the same shall have been approved by the Board & Perform such other duties as may be required of him. Herein-after specified.

Sec. 2. It Shall be the duty of the Vice President, to perform all of the duties of the President, in case of his absence or the vacation of his Office

Sec. 3. The duties of the Secretary Shall be, to keep on Hand in Charge the Books of the Company; Said Books Shall be Open at all times, to the inspection of any and all of the stockholders: His special duties Shall be to act, as secretary of all the meetings of the Company Regular & Special, the Minutes of which Shall be Recorded in a Book kept for such purpose. He shall also act as secretary of the Board of Directors, but Shall have no vote on any business matter before said board the Minutes of the transactions of the Board Shall also be entered in a book kept for such purpose. The Reports of the Superintendent and Treasurer Shall also be copied in said Book keeping on file the Originals, all orders or checks drawn on the Treasurer, for the Payment of Bills, etc. and Dividends, when audited and approved by the Board, the Certificate issued by the Secretary before Payment Shall be made; He shall also keep in a Book for the purpose, an account of the water tickets sold by the Treasurer, when said tickets are returned to the Board by the Superintendent said tickets shall also be kept, & placed on file.

He shall keep an Indexed Stock Book in which shall be an account, shall be opened with each Share Holder, which Book shall also contain a Register of each Share of Stock issued, with the date, number & name of the Person, <sup>or persons</sup> to whom each Certificate was issued, corresponding with that of the Certificate; He shall keep a D. & Cr. Ac with the Treasurer, Balancing the same every month an Expense Ac shall also be kept, in which shall be entered in proper form, the Recorded Minutes of the Board, all the Expenses of the Company He shall Counter-sign the Certificates of stock and shall report, at the monthly meetings the financial condition of the Company & perform such other duties as may, from time to time be required of him, by the Board of Directors.

Sec. 4. The duties of the Treasurer shall be to Receive on deposit, all monies of the Company, and no Order, Draft or Check shall be paid by him unless signed & Counter-signed by the President & Secretary, and approved by the Board of Directors. He shall issue water tickets on payment, being made to him in advance by the party applying to him for water, except, in such cases as may be hereinafter specified, He shall require of all parties, presenting for payment order, Drafts, or Checks, to receipt, the same on the back of said order, Draft, or Check. His Books shall also be open for the inspection of the Board of Directors or any stock Holder, at any & all times, He shall also report to the Board of Directors Monthly or oftener if required and perform such other duties as may be required of him by the Board & Company.

Sec. 5. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent to have a general supervision of the Ditch and its appurtenances. To gauge the water for Consumers; Water Tickets purchased by Consumers, shall be placed in the hands of the Superintendent, who shall give said Consumer, credit for the same, on a Book kept for that purpose. He shall give the party one days notice of the expiration of his ticket, & should he (the consumer) fail to procure another, his supply of water shall be shut off, all water tickets, which have expired, shall be returned by him (the Superintendent,) to the Board of Directors weekly. He shall also superintend the completion of the ditch and see that it is kept in proper repair shall put in water gates, make weekly Reports to the Board of Directors, of the general condition of the Ditch, and its appurtenances, and give such other information as may be required of interest to the Company and also perform such other duties as may be from time to time, be required of him by the Board of Directors & the Company.

Sec. 6 The duties of the Board of Directors shall be to have a general supervision of business and interests of the Company, to audit and attest all Bills and accounts of the Company said Bills & accounts when so audited & approved shall be signed by the President & Secretary before payment shall be made by the Treasurer they shall declare the Monthly Dividends and order the payment of the same they shall order the issuing the certificates of Stock, approve all contracts and agreements binding the Company prior to their being signed by the President & Secretary. They shall hold their meetings on Saturday evening of each week, for the transaction of such business

as may be presented for their Consideration  
 to Regulate the price of water, from time to time  
 as may be for the interests of the Company  
 They shall have power, to suspend the Superintendant  
 -dant for neglect of duty, or for any just and reasonable  
 cause, until the first regular meeting thereafter  
 when on presenting the case to the Company he  
 shall be discharged from the Service of the Com-  
 pany, or acquitted and retained in office - they  
 shall order the Calls for special meetings of  
 the Company by giving five days notice  
 they shall have power, to hire water agents  
 when it becomes necessary from the increased  
 business of the Company, they shall, when  
 it appears necessary, place men on the  
 upper end of the Ditch to keep it in order  
 and report through their Secretary, at the  
 monthly meetings, the general Condition  
 of the Company

Section 7. The Secretary shall receive for his Service  
 the sum of Ten Dollars per month, during  
 the Mining Season

The Treasurer shall receive two per cent  
 of all water sold by the Company

The Superintendent, shall receive for his  
 services the sum of four Dollars per day  
 during the Mining Season,

Sec 8. The Treasurer shall give good and sufficient  
 Bonds to the Company, in the sum of  
 Two Thousand Dollars, for the faithful  
 performance of his duties, said bonds  
 to be approved by the Board of Directors

- Sec. 9 The holder, (in person or by written proxy,) of each share of stock - when said stock is properly recorded in the Books of the Company, shall be entitled to one vote, for each share so held, at any Business Meeting of the Company
- Sec 10 At the Monthly Meetings, of the Company, <sup>or special</sup> on motion of any three Stock Holders present, the vote on any question shall be taken, by a vote, of the Shares of stock represented at such Meeting
- Sec 11 Transfer of stock shall be by Endorsement and bill of transfer, and said Bill of transfer shall be recorded in the Books of the Company
- Sec 12 The Company shall hold Monthly Meetings on the first Tuesday Evening of each Month during the Mining season.
- Sec 13. Special Meetings of the Company may be called by a written Request, of five Stock Holders, when such Request is approved by the Board of Directors, and five days of the Meeting shall be given in writing signed by the President and Secretary
- Sec 14 The Annual Election for the Election of Officers of the Company shall take place on the first Tuesday of September of each year. Notice of which shall be given at the Regular Meeting held on the first Tuesday of August of each year, Special Elections for the filling of vacancies in the offices of the Company shall be called by the Board, by giving three weeks

Sec 15, A Majority of the Shares of stock, Shall constitute a business quorum at any regular or special Meeting of the Company Any Two of the Board of Directors, Shall constitute a business quorum at any meeting of the Board.

Sec 16. Any officer of the Company, chargeable with neglect of his duties, or any misdemeanors in office may be removed by a vote of the Majority of the Shares of stock.

Sec 17, The Board of Directors Shall have power to give an order on the Treasurer, for a plain Head of water, for one week, when the applicant is unable to pay in advance. At the end of the week, such ticket must be paid before another will be issued to the Company.

Sec 19, Cash, books and its banks, shall be entitled first, to the water, when it is all wanted there.

Sec 20, Stock Holders Shall have the preference over Non Stock holders in the use of water.

Sec 21. These By Laws may be altered or amended at any Regular Meeting of the Company.

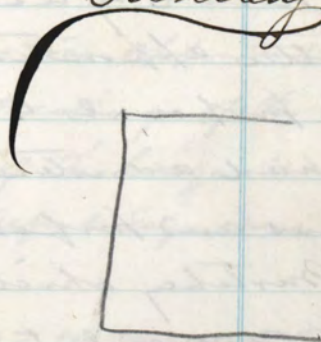
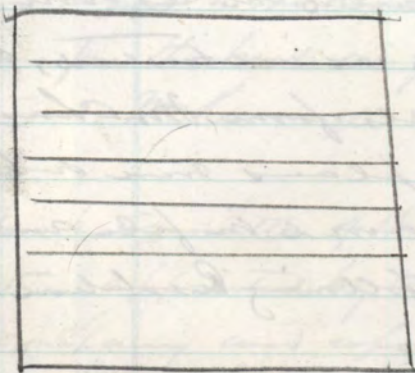
