

An Ordinance.

Concerning the Public Library of the City of Salida, Colorado.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Salida, Colorado:-

Section 1 That there be established and maintained a free public library and reading room within the City of Salida, Colorado, for the use and benefits of the inhabitants thereof, according to the provisions of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Colorado entitled, "An Act concerning free public libraries and reading rooms in cities and incorporate towns", approved April 10, 1899; and the City Council of this city may levy a tax therefor of not to exceed one mill on the dollar annually upon all taxable property in this city; such taxes to be levied and collected in like manner with the general taxes of the city and to be known as the "Library Fund".

Sec. 2 That the Mayor of this city be and he is hereby instructed to appoint six suitable persons, which appointees, when approved by the City Council, together with the Mayor(who shall be President), shall constitute, and be known as " The Board of Directors of the Public Library of the City of Salida, Colorado".

Sec. 3 Said Board of Directors, under the name and style designated in Section 2 hereof, shall constitute a body corporate under the laws of the State of Colorado, and shall have all the powers conferred by said Act concerning free libraries and reading rooms, and all other powers that may by law be conferred upon them; and the said board of directors shall have the power to make such by-laws, rules and regulations as shall effectually carry out the intent and provisions of said Act in the management of said Public library.

Approved and adapted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Salida, Colo, this 21st day of September^{A.D.} 1908.
