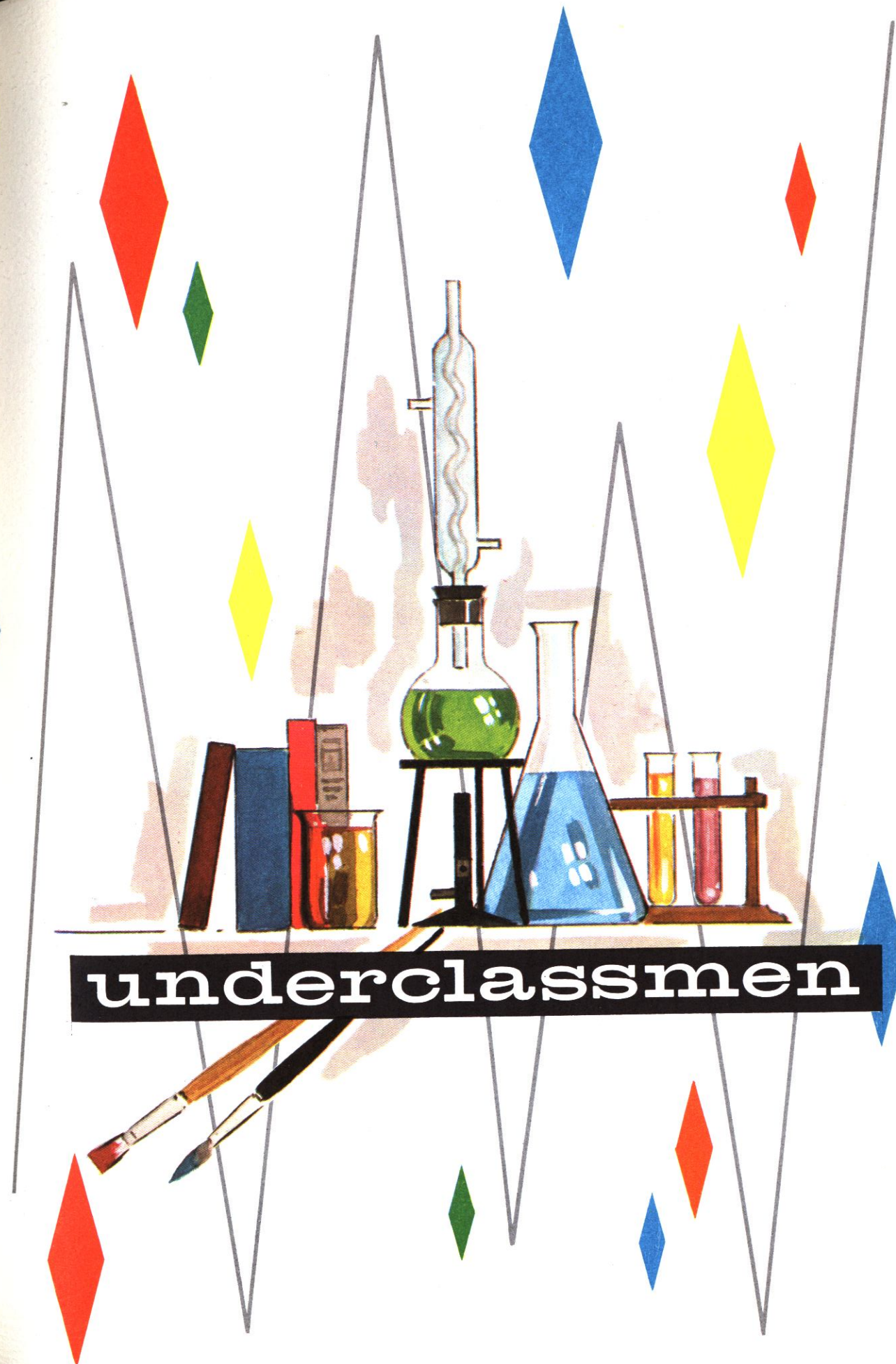
In September, 1956, a class of 91 humble and bewildered freshmen entered High School. The class of 1960 began its freshmen year by electing Ronald Cox as President, Gene Burgner as Vice President, Karen Decker as Secretary-Treasurer, and Betty Cosslett, Ben Beauregard and Shirley Woods as Student Council Representatives. The class won first prize for their float in the Homecoming Parade. Mr. Ford was the class sponsor.

In its sophomore year the class of '60 won third prize for their float in the Homecoming Parade. Mr. Soles was the sponsor, Rickey Carroll, Lance Stapleton, and Barbara Berry were elected President, Vice President, and Secretary-Treasurer, respectively. Betty Crosslett, Ben Beauregard, and Mike Phillips were chosen as Student Council Representatives.

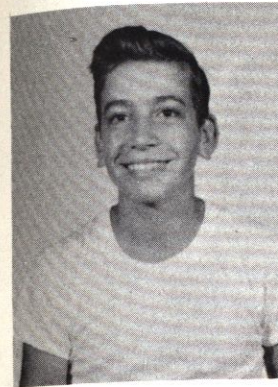
During its junior year, the class, under the sponsorship of Mr. Kurtz and Mrs. LeMay, took charge of the concession stand during football season to finance the Junior-Senior Prom which was given May 2. The theme of the prom was "Oriental Gardens." The class entered a float in the Homecoming Parade. Class officers were Rickey Carroll, President; Lance Stapleton, Vice-President; Magdalene Martinez, Secretary; and Barbara Berry, Treasurer. Betty Cosslett, Ben Beauregard, Linda Jauch, and Mike Phillips, were elected as Student Council Representatives.

When at last the class reached senior status, it had dwindled to 65. This class again entered a float in the Homecoming Parade and took second place. Homecoming Queen was Nancy Griffith and her attendants were Sally Yokley, Shirley Woods, and Karen Decker. Shirley Woods was Winter Festival Queen and her attendant was Debbie Sheeley. Larry Predovich and Carl Reno were football captains. The following were elected as officers of the graduating class: Mike Ewing, President; Jerry Smith, Vice-President; Debbie Sheeley, Secretary; and Rose Williams, Treasurer. Rickey Carroll was elected as Student Body President and Lance Stapleton was Vice President. Betty Cosslett, Ben Beauregard, Mike Phillips, and Gilbert Gallegos were elected to the Student Council.

As is tradition in Salida High, purple and white were taken as class colors for the senior year. The class chose the purple and white orchid as its flower. A class day assembly was held in the spring and Baccalaureate was held on May 29. Commencement took place on June 2 and the members of the class, some feeling a twinge of nostalgia and all feeling triumphant, ended their High School career.

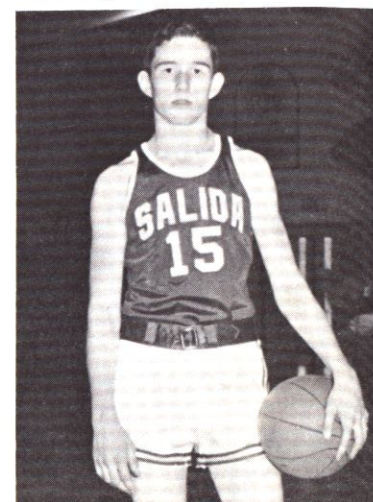
Salida High School won Second Place in the league. This was the second conference game lost in four years. In the last four years Salida has won 18 conference games and has lost 2.
