This year, the students in the CMC classes are learning how to be more independent as they work through their assignments in this class. Being in this class teaches you independence and how to be more selfsufficient.
























Our History Playlist



























Our Math Playlist

In Pre-Calculus this year the students practiced their skills with past subject matter as well as learned new and challenging problems.





























